<u>Procurement Specialist</u> (TN): International corporation has immediate opening for a Procurement Specialist with strong experience sourcing and buying aluminum die castings. The majority of sourcing will involve Asian suppliers. BS degree preferred, but not required.

<u>Logistics Manager</u> (TN): Major Tier 1 automotive facility needs a Logistics Manager to direct 40+ employees in customer service, material handling and warehousing. Knowledge of SAP is a plus. BS degree and Tier 1 automotive experience required.

<u>Lean Manufacturing Expert</u> (NC): Tier 1 automotive plant needs Lean / Six Sigma expert to standardize current & new processes and methods, reduce process variation, identify waste, and methodically eliminate waste. Requires BS degree and Six Sigma Black Belt.

The Importance of Enthusiasm

We've had some really good candidates lose out on job opportunities recently, not because their skills were off the mark, but because they appeared to lack enthusiasm for the job. In interview situations it is critical that candidates come across as energetic, upbeat, and personable. Companies want to hire people they will enjoy interacting with on a daily basis.

Candidates who interview well do the following things:

- Research the company thoroughly prior to the interview
- Prepare a list of questions to ask during the interview
- Speak in an upbeat, positive manner
- Find out how the most pressing problems relate to the job function, then discuss how they tackled similar issues in the past
- Relax during the interview
- Demonstrate that they are "do-ers" who can get things accomplished.

Remember, companies want to hire people who put energy into the work environment, not those who take energy out. Show companies that you have a passion for what you do.

Chambers of Commerce Have Valuable Information:

When considering a job offer involving relocation, it's a good idea to contact the local Chamber of Commerce to get information on the area. The Chamber can often mail you valuable information on schools, prospective employers for your spouse, realtor listings, apartment guides, local tax rates, demographics, and recreational activities.
